The Alaska Bird Club Emergency Response Committee is gathering information to be used in case of a large-scale disaster, such as an earthquake, wildfire, prolonged winter power outage, or other disaster that might bring about the need for an emergency response. *This information will be kept confidential and will only be used by the Emergency Response Committee for planning and emergency response purposes.*

Self sufficiency and preparedness will increase the chances of surviving a disaster with family and flock intact.
