The Alaska Bird Club Emergency Response Committee is gathering information to be used in case of a large-scale disaster, such as an earthquake, wildfire, prolonged winter power outage, or other disaster that might bring about the need for an emergency response. This information will be kept confidential and will only be used by the Emergency Response Committee for planning and emergency response purposes.

Please take a few moments to read and fill out the survey. It can be mailed to The Alaska Bird Club (P.O. Box 101825, Anchorage, AK 99510-1825) or dropped off at the next club meeting.

Self sufficiency and preparedness will increase the chances of surviving a disaster with family and flock intact. You can take some simple steps now to prepare your flock for the possibility of in-home emergency sheltering or evacuation. 
